China Computer Forensics Conference is a high-level and new perspective annual gathering of international academics and professionals, which was initiated and founded by China Computer Forensic Research Team in 2005. The first two conferences have been very successful. After constant improvement and development, the Conference has gradually developed into an international conference from a domestic professional meeting. Apart from the relevant domestic law enforcement departments and the judiciary, the Conference participants also include practitioners from the fields of finance, education, business consulting and investigation and IT information security, as well as experts and professionals from many other counties and regions.
